Appointments

Please ring **(09) 236 8068** for an appointment.

Every effort will be made to accommodate your preferred time. However, emergencies will always be given priority. Our reception staff will attempt to contact you if there are any unforeseen delays or if your GP has been called away.

Longer consultation times are available. Please ask our receptionist if you require extra time but be aware there is a fee.

Payments

Fees are payable at the time of consultation. We accept eftpos, cheque, visa, mastercard and online payments. Paywave is now available.

Fees for enrolled and registered patients are subsidised by the Government for various age groups and services costs are listed at the practice.

If you have any queries, please contact reception. They are happy to help.

Repeat Prescriptions

We are happy to issue repeat prescriptions for you. However, we ask that you give us as much advance notice as possible — 48 hours' warning being the minimum.

Repeat prescriptions do incur a charge (\$20) and the doctor may need to see you prior to issuing for clinical and/or legal reasons — especially if you are not seeing your regular GP.
